Phase I Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs) Upon contract award, transit operators become responsible for managing fleet maintenance facilities. Phase I ESAs are a critical tool for managing risk prior to entering a lease agreement.

Stormwater Permitting and Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Development

Most states require the transportation sector to be covered under an Industrial Stormwater Discharge Permit or to file for an exclusion from permitting. Development of an SWPPP is a permit requirement that helps a facility minimize the potential for pollutants to migrate off-site via stormwater runoff.

Stormwater Regulatory Compliance Monitoring, Reporting, & Training

Employee training is another permit requirement that equips staff with knowledge of how to manage stormwater pollution risks and how to respond to a spill. Most states also require semiannual or quarterly stormwater monitoring and reporting.

Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasures (SPCC) Plan Development

The USEPA requires facilities that maintain 1,320 gallons of oil in containers 55 gallons or greater to develop an SPCC Plan that outlines spill prevention and response procedures.

Chemical Inventory Reporting

Chemical inventories maintained above a certain threshold at a facility are subject to reporting to local and state reporting

Storage Tank Permitting

Most states require certain aboveground and underground storage tanks to be permitted prior to installation.
